Professor David Bennett is the Associate Dean at the University of Glasgow Veterinary Faculty and head of The Comparative Molecular Medicine and Therapeutics group. In addition to his clinical and teaching interests, his current research includes osteoarthritis in cats, the role of cytokines in arthritis and other sites of inflammation, the application of gene therapy to arthritis and the use of stem cells in cartilage repair.

Professor Bennett has received numerous awards and is an honorary life member of the British Veterinary Orthopaedic Association in recognition of his outstanding contributions to small animal orthopaedics. He has over 300 publications and is on the editorial boards of *Veterinary Comparative Orthopaedics and Traumatology*, as well as the *Journal of Feline Medicine and Surgery*.
